AWARD INFORMATION

All Challenge awards are One Horse/One Rider. Horses may participate in multiple age divisions with different riders. Buckles to be awarded for the High Point in each Challenge Division. DECLARATION REQUIRED. \$10 Declaration Fee per Horse/Rider pair per Challenge Division/Award. Declaration for the <u>full</u> <u>3-show circuit</u>, not per show. Points will count from all classes listed.

Reining Challenge. ISHSA Reining, ISHSA Reiner Rail, ISHSA Reiner Conformation, IdBHA Freestyle Reining and IdBHA Working Ranch Horse (not offered at the 1st show). <u>Buckles in 3 Divisions</u>: All Ages/Open; NonPro; and Youth

Showmanship Challenge. ISHSA Showmanship, and IdBHA Freestyle Showmanship. <u>Buckles in 5</u> <u>Divisions</u>: 11 & Under, 13 & Under, 14 to 18, 19 to 49, and 50 & Over

English Challenge. ISHSA English Pleasure (age division, Ltd Rider or 2-Gait), ISHSA English Equitation (age division, Ltd. Rider or 2-Gait), ISHSA Disciplined Rail, IdBHA Disciplined Rail, and IdBHA Freestyle English Pattern. <u>Buckles in 5 Divisions</u>: Walk/Trot, 13 & Under, 14 to 18, 19 to 49, and 50 & Over

Western Challenge. ISHSA Western Pleasure (age division, Ltd Rider or 2-gait), ISHSA Horsemanship (age division, Ltd Rider or 2-Gait), IdBHA Freestyle Western Pattern, and IdBHA Western Disciplined Rail. <u>Buckles in 5 Divisions</u>: Walk/Trot, 13 & Under, 14 to 18, 19 to 49, and 50 & Over

In-Hand Challenge. ISHSA In-Hand Trail and IdBHA Freestyle In-Hand Trail. <u>Buckles in 2 Divisions</u>: 3 & Under, and 4 & Over.

Trail Challenge. ISHSA Trail, IdBHA Freestyle Trail, and IdBHA Challenge Trail. <u>Buckles in 5 divisions</u>: Walk/Trot, 13 & Under, 14 to 18, 19 to 49, and 50 & Over

Driving Challenge. ISHSA Pleasure Driving, ISHSA Disciplined Rail Driving, ISHSA Reinsmanship Driving, and IdBHA Freestyle Reinsmanship Driving. Awards to be determined Multiple Divisions: Miniature/Small Cart, Horse/Large Cart. In the event adequate youth and adults declare and participate in at least 2 of the above classes <u>and</u> there are adequate youth and adults to split the class and leave a minimum of 2 exhibitors in each age division, the division will be split and a 2nd award offered. At Management discretion (with input of Exhibitors), Buckle may be substituted with similar/equal award.

Gymkhana Challenge. All Gymkhana classes. Buckles in 3 Divisions: Walk/Trot, 18 & Under, and 19 & Over

SPECIAL RULES

Walk/Trot 11 & Under and Walk/Trot Ltd Riders may NOT cross-enter loping/cantering classes of any type. Walk/Trot Gymkhana participants WILL BE DISQUALIFIED if they canter or lope at any point in the pattern.

IdBHA, Freestyle, Challenge Classes or other NON-APPROVED ISHSA classes:

- English Classes (including Mounted Trail and Showmanship) waive jackets, exhibitors may wear heeled-shoes or boots with half-chaps in lieu of tall boots, shirts must be collared with sleeves, waive hunt caps/helmets.
- Western Classes (including Showmanship, In-Hand, Mounted Trail, Reining) waive hats (helmets always accepted), waive long sleeves.

Gymkhana - waive long sleeves and hats (helmets always accepted).

CLASS INFORMATION

<u>FREESTYLE CLASSES</u> – "Freestyle" classes (except Trail and In-hand Trail) will have cones set at clock points 3:00, 6:00, 9:00 and 12:00, with a center point. Pattern must start at 6:00 position (Judge will be at 9:00 position). Exhibitors do <u>not</u> have to incorporate the markers into their pattern, no other markers or props may be added to the area. Points awarded for precision, difficulty, show presentation and overall impression – so get creative. Penalty for pattern exceeding time limit. HELPFUL HINT: If intimidated at the prospect of creating your own pattern, start with any pattern posted at the show or a previous show (you probably have some patterns in your trailer) – then simply take out the things you don't like (or can't do well), and add in what you wish it had included because you like to do it, or do it well. You are NOT required to provide your pattern (so if you mess it up, just smile and keep going.

<u>Freestyle Showmanship</u> – May be shown English or Western. Mandatory movements 1) walk; 2) jog or trot (or 2^{nd} Gait); 3) 180 degree turn; 4) halt; and 5) back. Pattern must end squared before the judge, and ready for inspection. Inspection will be at judge's discretion. Each Exhibitor will be given 60 seconds to impress the judge with their skills.

<u>Freestyle English Pattern</u> and <u>Freestyle Western Pattern</u> – Mandatory movements include 1) walk; 2) jog/trot (or 2^{nd} Gait); 3) canter/ lope; 4) 180 degree turn (your choice); 5) stop/halt and 6) back. Pattern must end on left side of arena, allowing horse to exit behind the judge and not interfere with the next rider's pattern. Each Exhibitor will be given 90 seconds to impress the judge with their skills.

<u>Freestyle In-Hand Trail</u> – Mandatory movements include walk, jog (or 2^{nd} Gait), bridge and gate. Obstacles may be worked in any order, obstacles may be worked more than once, points to be awarded for difficulty of obstacle in addition to performance of obstacle. Each Exhibitor will be given 120 seconds to impress the judge with their skills.

<u>Freestyle (Mounted) Trail</u> – Mandatory movements include walk, jog (or 2nd Gait), lope, bridge, and must go over at least 1 pole. Obstacles may be worked in any order, obstacles may be worked more than once, points to be awarded for difficulty of obstacle in addition to performance of obstacle. Each Exhibitor will be given 90 seconds to impress the judge with their skills. May be ridden English or Western

<u>Freestyle Reinsmanship Driving</u> – Mandatory movements include walk, collected trot, working trot, halt, and rein back. Each Exhibitor will be given 90 second to impress the judge with their skills.

<u>Freestyle Reining</u> – Mandatory movements include one circle right, one circle left, one spin (360) left, one spin (360) right, one lead change, one sliding stop OR rundown. Each Exhibitor will be given 4 minutes (from beginning of music to end of performance) to impress the judge with their skills. May be ridden with 2 hands regardless of bit; senior horses may be ridden in snaffle. Saddle not required; Music not required; Costume not required.
