**Reining classes will be held Friday night not to start before 6:30pm**

**Gymkhana will be Saturday after English!!**

**Show Time: Friday, April 20 – 2:00 pm. show office opens Not to start before 6:30pm**

**Show Time: Saturday, April 21 – 6:00 a.m. show office opens 7:30 a.m. show begins**

**Show Time: Sunday, April 22 – 7:00 a.m. show office opens 8:00 a.m. show begins**

**Arena will be open until Midnight Friday evening (in and around in-hand trail set up) and closed Saturday after Gymkhana for trail set-up.**

Patterns will be available for you to print off the website by April 10. Patterns will be available at the show office.

**Entry Fees: ISHSA Classes: \$12.00 per class, plus \$2.00 per horse one-time promotion fee, plus \$2.00 per horse one-time awards fee – for a total of \$16.00 for the first class, then just \$12.00 for each additional class.**

**APHA Classes: \$20.00/Class + APHA Show Fee \$5.00/horse + \$2.00 per horse one-time awards fee APHA Horses only**

**APHA Class Rules:**

- The Show Secretary or office staff MUST inspect the registration papers (or copies of ) on each horse entered. Entries shall be made in the name of the recorded owner. (RULE SC-160.C. Geldings are not allowed to show with stallion papers.
- Leased Horses – the Show Secretary or office staff MUST inspect the APHA show lease certificate (RULES AM-020.A.1.f & YP-015.A.2.f.
- To enter Amateur classes you MUST present current year APHA Amateur or Novice Amateur card, and own your horse (RULES AM-015, AM-210, AM-300.C).
- All Exhibitors and Owners must present a current APHA Membership Card (Rule SC-160.A). The condition of submitting entries or the first entry in to the show ring of a horse or exhibitor shall be deemed as acceptance of the APHA Official Rule Book.

To pre-register, call *Shawn Charters* (208) 830-6123, or e-mail [chartersconsulting@gmail.com](mailto:chartersconsulting@gmail.com) by **MIDNIGHT, Tuesday, April 17th**. Pre-entries for the double point will have any necessary information ready for pick-up on **Friday after 2:00pm**; otherwise you must enter in person during the show. The secretary will collect the show fees when you pick up your number or check in. Horses will not be allowed to enter classes unless class fees are paid, or a deposit is left with the show office. A signed “blank” check satisfies the “deposit” rule. Numbers will not be handed out without one of the above. Class scratches must be done two classes in advance of scratched class to receive a refund, or you will be charged for it. ISHSA will assess a \$25.00 fee for any bank returned checks and will hold your year end points until all money is paid.

**Please check in with the office and finalize your bill with the secretary before you leave the show grounds.**

Stalls, Shavings and RV Spaces are available; reserve online at [www.fordidahohorsepark.com/Reservations.aspx](http://www.fordidahohorsepark.com/Reservations.aspx) -- or call the Ford Idaho Horse Park **(208)442-3335** for more info. Load in day is Friday, April 20th. Stalls are \$27.00 per day/night.

If you load in Thursday April 19<sup>th</sup> for Ranch Horse day, stall is still \$27.00/day/night. Thursday thru Sunday would be 3 nights for a total of \$81.00, Friday thru Sunday would be \$54.00. One day would be \$27.00. If you haul in any earlier there is a \$17.00/day charge.

**Please remember ABSOLUTELY NO lunging in the indoor arena. (Ford Idaho Horse Park Rules)**

**NO dogs allowed inside arena building at any time. Any dogs on the grounds must be on a leash, no exceptions**

*This show is also approved for PAC Credits, ACAAP Approved and AHA-OIEP Approved.*

**TRAIL CLASSES-** Trail will be held in the main arena Sunday morning. We will be running two trail courses and will have each main judge paired up with one local judge. One course will be the walk/trot course and one course will be the course for loping horses. This will eliminate keeping all our exhibitors waiting needlessly. Walk Trot course will be closest to the in-gate. Lope course will be closest to the announcer's booth. Walk-Trot Trail classes will begin promptly at 8:00!! Lope trial classes will begin at 8:30. APHA classes will be run after Open classes with both APHA judges.

**Warm up Trail Cost:** If you are entered in ANY TRAIL CLASS Sunday you will be accessed an \$8 trail warm up fee PER COURSE, unlimited goes and time per course. If you are only signed up for one class only one \$8 fee will be assessed. No need to reserve a time slot. Trail warm-up time will be from 5:30 am to 7:30 am. NO people will be allowed to walk the course during warm-ups!! No Exceptions! Individuals will be allowed a 15 minute walk-thru (no horses) after Riding Warm-up.

## **CLASS AND AWARD INFORMATION**

**"To qualify for ANY of the High Point and Circuit awards – You MUST be CURRENT 2018 ISHSA MEMBER.**

**High Point, Reserve and Circuit awards are based on One Rider/One Horse Team – Your horse may be led in halter class by someone else. This is the ONLY exception. Only one halter class will count (for those horses with multiple registries. Halter class must be declared before start of show.**

**\*\*\* You do NOT need to be an ISHSA member to show in any class and win the class ribbons\*\*\***

**HALTER CLASSES-** Grand and Reserve at halter is for first and second place winners only from each class. Please be sure to comeback for Grand and Reserve in your division – Neck Ribbons for Grand and Reserve!

**Champion of Champions:** Grand at halter for stallions, mares and geldings will compete for this award. Neck ribbons for Champion of Champions!

**REINING - High Point Reining Horse** (classes 1 or 2 or 3, plus 4 and 5) – must show all 3 classes to qualify.

**HIGH POINT IN-HAND HORSE-** In-Hand horse/handler will be eligible only to those who exhibit animals that do not drive or ride. You must exhibit in the In Hand Trail class (class 34 or 35) as well as your respective halter class (class 6-10,12-16 or18-22) to qualify. Your age division showmanship class (class 25, 26, 28, 29, 30, 31) also counts for High Point In-Hand. Highest total of points in those "3" classes will win award!

**HIGH POINT GYMKHANA HORSE-** Classes 84, 85, 88, 89, 92, 93, 96, 97 count for this High Point. You must show all 4 classes in your age division to qualify for this award. All times will be added together, the "fastest" combined times wins High Point. Walk-Trot games do not count towards this award.

**HIGH POINT - 11 & Under (Walk-Trot)** – Classes 30, 41, 73, 83, 87, 91, 95, 102, 122, 147 and horse MUST be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (Classes 12-15 or 18-21). (choose just 6 of 10 classes – form will be available-must show halter) Halter points count using 1<sup>st</sup>=6, 2<sup>nd</sup>=5, 3<sup>rd</sup>=4, 4<sup>th</sup>=3, 3<sup>rd</sup>=2, 6<sup>th</sup>=1.

**HIGH POINT – Walk-Trot Limited Rider – 12 yrs and over-** Classes 44, 74, 86, 90, 94, 98, 100, 125, 148 and one of the following: 25, 26, 28 or 29 and horse MUST be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (class 6-9, 12-15 or 18-21) (choose just 6 of 10 classes – form will be available- must show halter). Halter points count using 1<sup>st</sup>=6, 2<sup>nd</sup>=5, 3<sup>rd</sup>=4, 4<sup>th</sup>=3, 3<sup>rd</sup>=2, 6<sup>th</sup>=1.

**HIGH POINT – 13 & Under** - Classes 29, 52, 80, 104, 131, 154 and horse **MUST** be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (Classes 6-9 or 12-15). Halter points count using 1<sup>st</sup>=6, 2<sup>nd</sup>=5, 3<sup>rd</sup>=4, 4<sup>th</sup>=3, 3<sup>rd</sup>=2, 6<sup>th</sup>=1.

**HIGH POINT – 14 thru 18** – Classes 28, 51, 79, 105, 130, 153 and horse **MUST** be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (Classes 6-9 or 12-15). Halter points count using 1<sup>st</sup>=6, 2<sup>nd</sup>=5, 3<sup>rd</sup>=4, 4<sup>th</sup>=3, 3<sup>rd</sup>=2, 6<sup>th</sup>=1.

**HIGH POINT – 19 thru 49**– Classes 26, 50, 78, 106, 129, 152 and horse **MUST** be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (class 6-9, 12-15, 18-21). Halter points count using 1<sup>st</sup>=6, 2<sup>nd</sup>=5, 3<sup>rd</sup>=4, 4<sup>th</sup>=3, 3<sup>rd</sup>=2, 6<sup>th</sup>=1. Gaited Horse Contestants are eligible for this award as well, so Gaited horse classes: 26, 66, 67, 75, 101, 134, 135, 149 (choose just 6 of 8 classes – form will be available) and horse **MUST** be shown in Halter to Qualify for the award (Classes 6-9, 12-15 or 18-21).

**HIGH POINT – 50 and over**– Classes 25, 49, 77, 107, 128, 155 and horse **MUST** be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (class 6-9, 12-15, 18-21). Gaited Horse Contestants are eligible for this award as well, so Gaited horse classes: 25, 66, 67, 75, 101, 134, 135, 149 (choose just 6 of 8 classes – form will be available) and horse **MUST** be shown in Halter to Qualify for the award (Classes 6-9, 12-15, 18-21). Halter points count using 1<sup>st</sup>=6, 2<sup>nd</sup>=5, 3<sup>rd</sup>=4, 4<sup>th</sup>=3, 3<sup>rd</sup>=2, 6<sup>th</sup>=1.

**HIGH POINT LARGE CART**– Classes 37, 39, 46, 58. Horse **MUST** be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (class 6-9, 12-15, 18-21). Halter points count using 1<sup>st</sup>=6, 2<sup>nd</sup>=5, 3<sup>rd</sup>=4, 4<sup>th</sup>=3, 3<sup>rd</sup>=2, 6<sup>th</sup>=1.

**HIGH POINT SMALL CART**– Classes 38, 40, 47, 59 Horse **MUST** be shown in Halter to qualify for the award (class 9-10, 15-16 or 21-22). Halter points count using 1<sup>st</sup>=6, 2<sup>nd</sup>=5, 3<sup>rd</sup>=4, 4<sup>th</sup>=3, 3<sup>rd</sup>=2, 6<sup>th</sup>=1.

**CIRCUIT AWARDS**– Each High Point will have a “Circuit award” combining the Spring Double Point show points with the Fall Double Point show points, for an overall CIRCUIT award prize! **You must show in BOTH Double Point shows to qualify for this award! You must show in the same qualifying halter class in Spring & Fall show (for horses with multiple registries).**
