The \$1 amount is included in the entry fee. This will allow clubs putting on shows to charge an entry fee that will help them to make money (not just break even, shows can be expensive to put on) while also being exhibitor friendly. Due to Covid-19, we have decided not to hold an in person banquet. We want to keep our members safe and there is no telling what stage we will be in come February, when the banquet usually is. We will however be holding a Facebook Live to announce all our high point winners and present what they have won. Date and time will be announced at a later date.
