Show approval forms are on the website & need to be sent to Anne. The fee has been reduced to \$30 for 2023. Some advantages to being an ISHSA approved show: use of the ISHSA insurance with no cost to the club, advertising on Facebook, ISHSA website & newsletter (if the showbill is presented to the rules committee 60 days before the show date), possibly more entries to an approved show, and most people will go in more classes for the year end points.
- ⇒**Permanent numbers need to be paid for by April 1st, no exceptions.** After that date, the number will be available for anyone to purchase. All proceeds go to the ISHSA Mel Gahley Scholarship Fund.

General Membership Meeting: 1-5--2023 Home of Tish Schuster

The meeting called to order by President Patricia Schuster

Minutes: approved as printed in newsletter.

Treasurers Report: The general account has \$467.62. The scholarship account has \$4,147.47. The double point account \$18517.08 Awards \$78.80 Report was approved.

Double Point Show: Spring dates are April 14 -16 at the Horse Park. APHA classes will be offered. Judges & show manager are hired. Show bill is at the rules committee. John had a request from Karaly for permission to let a special needs youth ride in lead line class. Since this not a judged class permission was granted. The two classes will be run concurrently.

Points secretary: n/a

Awards: The 2022 year end awards were well received. Robin pledged a donation of \$1,000 for awards. Maria offered to donate awards for the lead line group. Since this class is not judged & all contestants get awards, The same year end award must be given to all who complete 5 or more shows. Jamece will share this information with Maria. A big thank you to both ladies for stepping up with donations. Tish asked for a budget for the spring double point show awards & to purchase ribbons. Payment moved to the executive meeting. Anne said TVPHC would again donate \$300.00 for all of the reserve awards.

EPRB/LOC: Discussion on permanent numbers was held & the numbers must be purchased by April one. This rule will be strictly enforced.

Banquet: It was a success, John recommended we secure the Trolley house location & Good wood for caters for 2023.

New business: Anne brought up the show approval forms. After some discussion about having an ISHSA show vrs nonapproved. Discussion about incentive to have an approved show. More entries to an approved show plus most folks will go in more classes for the year end points. More entries, more money for year end awards.

John opened the discussion on class fees for 2023. It was agreed to stay with the \$10.00 cap. Show approval fee was discussed & we agreed that the dollar per class fee was funding the year end awards successfully so we could cut the 2023 show approval fee to \$30.00. Anne/ Felicia moved we cut the show approval fee to \$30.00. Approved

John asked about the number of members. Tish reported that 2022 we had 115 members, 2021/111 members, 2020/86 (covid year). It appears that the membership is holding fairly constant.

Jamece brought up advertising the TVPHC March schooling shows on the ISHSA website & facebook page. Our new policy is to not advertise non approved show. It was decided that since TVPHC gives regular donations to the double point shows, the March shows will be advertised.




