

# ISHSA YEAR-END HIGH POINT INFORMATION

- Exhibitor must compete at a minimum of 5 shows (all double point shows count as two shows) to qualify for year-end awards and be a paid member in good standing. Each class that you want to count towards high point must be shown in a minimum of 5 times. Points will count starting from date membership is paid.
- Only one breed class is to count (if horse has multiple breed registries) for any award that includes breed specific classes.
- This is a Horse/Rider pair award.
- You DO NOT have to declare for these awards but must meet all requirements to qualify for these awards.
- Payouts will be awarded to the top six exhibitors in all ISHSA approved classes. Must show in the class a minimum of 5 times to qualify for the payout.

**HIGH POINT SHOWMAN** – You must show in a minimum of 3 classes. Points from these 6 classes will count towards this award (age group classes only): Showmanship, English Equitation, English Pleasure, Trail, Horsemanship, and Western Pleasure.

6 high point divisions.....11 & Under Walk/Trot; Limited Rider Walk/Trot; 13 & Under; 14 to 18; 19 to 49; 50 & Over

6 reserve divisions.....11 & Under Walk/Trot; Limited Rider Walk/Trot; 13 & Under; 14 to 18; 19 to 49; 50 & Over

**HIGH POINT ENGLISH PERFORMANCE HORSE** - You must show in a minimum of 2 classes. Points from these 4 classes will count towards this award: English Pleasure JR or SR Horse (3-Gait English Pleasure for Gaited Horses), English Pleasure Open, English Pleasure Breed (2-Gait English Pleasure for Gaited Horses), and English Disciplined Rail (where available).

1 division..... Highest Point Earning Horse

**HIGH POINT WESTERN PERFORMANCE HORSE** - You must show in a minimum of 3 classes. Points from these 6 classes will count towards this award: Western Pleasure JR or SR Horse (3-Gait Western Pleasure for Gaited Horses), Western Pleasure Open, Western Pleasure Breed (2-Gait Western Pleasure for Gaited Horses), Western Disciplined Rail (where available), Western Riding, and Trail (Age division – excluding walk trot classes) or Trail 2 – Gait Open.

1 division..... Highest Point Earning Horse

**HIGH POINT DRIVING HORSE** – You must show in a minimum of 2 classes. Points from these 4 classes will count towards this award: Pleasure Driving, Roadster Driving, Disciplined Rail Driving, and Reinsmanship Driving.

2 high point divisions.....40" & Under; Over 40"

2 reserve divisions.....40" & Under; Over 40"

**HIGH POINT REINING HORSE** – You must show in a minimum of 2 classes. Points from these 3 classes will count towards this award: Reining (age division), Reining Open, and Reiner Rail.

2 divisions.....18 & Under; 19 & Over

**HIGH POINT GYMKHANA HORSE** – You must show in a minimum of 3 classes. Points from these 5 classes will count toward this award: Barrels, Poles, Key Race, Figure 8, and Flag Race.

4 high point divisions..... 11 & Under Walk/Trot; Limited Rider Walk/Trot; 18 & Under; 19 & Over

4 reserve divisions..... 11 & Under Walk/Trot; Limited Rider Walk/Trot; 18 & Under; 19 & Over

**HIGH POINT IN-HAND HORSE** – Points from these 3 classes will count toward this award: In-Hand Trail, Showmanship, and Halter. You must show in In-Hand Trail **AND** one other class to be eligible.

(only one showmanship class will count if exhibitor is eligible for more than one)

4 high point divisions.....3 & Under Mini/Pony; 3 & Under Horse/Pony; 4 & Over Mini/Pony; 4 & Over Horse/Pony

4 reserve divisions..... 3 & Under Mini/Pony; 3 & Under Horse/Pony; 4 & Over Mini/Pony; 4 & Over Horse/Pony

**HIGH POINT RANCH HORSE** – You must show in a minimum of 3 classes. Points from these 5 classes will count toward this award: Ranch Trail, Ranch Riding, Ranch Rail Pleasure, Ranch Reining (18 & Under/19 & Over), and Ranch Conformation

3 high point divisions..... Walk/Trot;18 & Under; 19 & Over

3 reserve divisions..... Walk/Trot;18 & Under; 19 & Over
